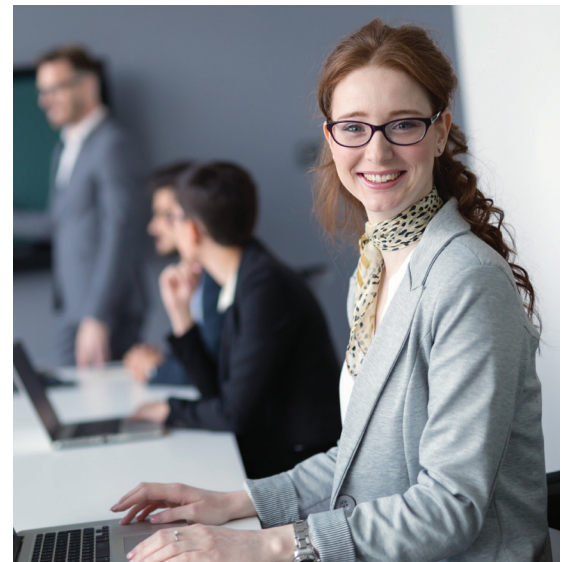

Required courses

The Knowledge Management certificate requires completion of 12 semester hours.

- BADM 535 Management Principles and Practices (3 SH)
- BIT 560 Management and Integration of IS Function (3 SH)
- BIT 566 Knowledge Management (3 SH)
- BIT 570 E-Business Strategy (3 SH)

Courses are eight weeks in length. BADM 535 and BIT 560 can be applied toward the Master of Science in Management degree. BADM 535 can be applied toward the Master of Science in Sports Management degree. BIT 560, BIT 566, and BIT 570 can be applied to the Master of Science in Information Systems degree.
