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Articulation Agreement

Minot State University and United Tribes Technical College

Effective: Fall 2023 Major: Psychology Degree: Bachelor of Science

The purpose of this articulation agreement is to enable students who have earned their Associate of Arts (AA) or Associate of Science (AS) degree from United Tribes Technical College (UTTC) to transfer to Minot State University (MISU) and enter the Psychology Bachelor of Science (BS) degree program.

The information contained within this agreement pertains to the 2023-2024 MISU catalog. Students satisfactorily completing the UTTC courses below may transfer the courses to MISU in fulfillment of the corresponding course requirements for this degree.

Students will complete their Associate of Science (AS) degree from UTTC. The student will be considered to have completed their general education courses in their UTTC AS degree and will only need to complete the additional MISU courses listed on page 2 of this document to graduate from MISU with a B.S. in Psychology.

UTTC students planning to transfer to MISU must have phone or e-mail contact with an adviser during their first semester at UTTC and first semester at MISU. Students may email Brett Williamson at UTTC at bwilliamson@uttc.edu or call Dr. Vicki Michels at MISU at 1-800-777-0750 or 1-701-858-3594.

Graduation with an MISU's Psychology major requires completion of major requirements and earning a C or better in all psychology courses, and earning a score falling in the percentile rank of no lower than one standard deviation below the national mean on the Psychology Major Field Test. Students must complete 60 credits at any four-year university and 30 credits from MISU to graduate from MISU. Students must have 120 total credit hours to graduate with their BS degree from MISU.

Admission to MISU. The MISU processes and considerations for evaluating applicants will be followed for admission. It is agreed that those students who receive the Associate of Arts or Associate of Science from UTTC and meet MISU admission criteria will be accepted without further review at MISU to the Psychology major. However, final admission to MISU is contingent on submission of the student's application.

Review & Termination. The term of this Agreement shall be for two years, beginning on the "Effective Date." The Parties agree to review this Agreement and the Program once during this period at a time mutually convenient for the Parties but aiming for during the year prior to the end of this agreement's term. Notification of revisions to MISU current and anticipated course offerings will also be sent to UTTC during the above review period. A Letter of Review will be sent between 30 and 60 days prior to contract expiration to ensure both parties can continue to fulfill the terms of this agreement or if contract revisions may be

required. This Agreement can be terminated by either party by giving written notice to the other party's designated representative at least 60 days prior to the commencement of a new academic semester.

Notices. All notices concerning this memorandum of agreement and understanding shall be in writing and will be considered to have been given at the time of receipt of notice by the other Party.
