Other acceptable placement exams include the Accuplacer Next Gen Quant Reasoning, ALEKS, EdReady (NROC), IETS HiSet, GED, MAA Maplesoft, Pearson, Smarter Balanced, and older SAT/ACCUPLACER Exams.
