1) **Art Portfolio**

This includes a minimum of 10 examples of art work done by the student. These items can be in any medium and can include all one medium or a variety of mediums. Please include descriptions of materials used and size of art works. The Art Portfolio will be accepted on a USB flash drive, a CD, or a PDF file only. Please make sure that digital images are well lit, cropped, and titled. Title, medium, size, and date of completion must also accompany the 10 images on a separate document.

2) **Cover Letter**

This letter should include a description of your motivation to create art in general, specific information about the works that you are including in your portfolio, your emphasis, or intended emphasis, at MSU (photography, painting, etc.), and the reasons why you are interested in receiving a scholarship.

3) **Transcript**

If you are an incoming freshman, please submit the most recent transcript from your high school. If you are a transfer or currently enrolled student, please submit your most recent MSU transcript. Both transcripts should include the current GPA.

**Selection Criteria:** Your application will be evaluated on your creativity, technical skills, and commitment observed in your portfolio, cover letter, transcripts, and recommendations. This should be evident in your application regardless if you are an incoming First Year Student, a Transfer Student, or a Continuing Art Major.

**Awards Criteria:** You must be an Art Major to be eligible for the Harvey & Arlene Twyman Scholarship. If you are awarded a scholarship, then, you must be an Art Major to receive this scholarship for each of the semesters in which the funds are dedicated.
