1) **Art Portfolio**

This includes a minimum of 10 examples of artwork done by the student. These items can be in any medium. The art portfolio will be accepted on a USB flash drive or CD only. Please make sure that digital images are well lit, cropped, and titled. Title, medium, size, and date of completion must also accompany the 10 images printed on a separate document.

2) **Cover Letter**

This letter should include a general description of your motivation to create art, specific information about the works that you are including in your portfolio, and your intended focus in art at MSU (photography, painting, etc.).

3) **Transcript**

If you are an incoming freshman, please submit the most recent transcript from your high school. If you are a transfer or currently enrolled student, please submit your most recent MSU transcript.

Selection Criteria: Your application will be evaluated on your creativity, technical skills, and commitment observed in your portfolio, cover letter, transcripts, and recommendations.

Awards Criteria: Only art majors are eligible for the Harvey & Arlene Twyman Scholarship. If awarded, you must remain an art major for each of the semesters in which the funds are dedicated.
