## REPORT HIGHLIGHTS

The information for this report was collected through mail surveys, follow-up telephone calls, and inquiries to academic departments. The office of Career Services surveyed students who received degrees from MSU for the terms ending in December 2005, May 2006, and August 2006. This report is based on responses from 550 graduates (95% of the reported 576 degrees granted).

### Of the 550 respondents:

--497 (90%) reported entering the job market.

--53 (10%) reported "Additional College."

### Of the 497 respondents entering the job market:

--361 (73%) reported "Employed in Major" or "Employed Related to Major."

--25 (5%) reported still "Active in Job Search."

--Graduates reported accepting employment in 34 states and 3 foreign countries.

--343 respondents reported accepting employment in North Dakota.
