## REPORT HIGHLIGHTS

The information for this report was collected through mail surveys, follow-up telephone calls, and inquiries to academic departments. The office of Career Services surveyed students who received degrees from MSU for the terms ending in December 2006, May 2007, and August 2007. This report is based on responses from 574 graduates (96% of the reported 600 degrees granted).

Of the 574 respondents:

500 (87%) reported entering the job market.

74 (13%) reported "Additional College."

Of the 500 respondents entering the job market:

369 (74%) reported "Employed in Major" or "Employed Related to Major."

25 (5%) reported still "Active in Job Search."

Graduates reported accepting employment in 27 states and 3 foreign countries.

340 respondents reported accepting employment in North Dakota.
