REPORT HIGHLIGHTS

The information for this report was collected through mail surveys, follow-up telephone calls, and inquiries to academic departments. The office of Career Services surveyed students who received degrees from MSU for the terms ending in December 2007, May 2008, and August 2008. This report is based on responses from 630 graduates (96% of the reported 654 degrees granted).

Of the 630 respondents:

548 (87%) reported entering the job market.

82 (13%) reported "Additional College."

Of the 548 respondents entering the job market:

384 (70%) reported "Employed in Major" or "Employed Related to Major."

43 (8%) reported still "Active in Job Search."

Graduates reported accepting employment in 33 states and 3 foreign countries.

367 respondents reported accepting employment in North Dakota.
