- 1. Minot State University (MSU) is committed to the protection of its students, employees, visitors, facilities, information systems, and financial resources. The purpose of the Loss Control Committee (LCC) is to provide policy guidance on matters affecting risk management, environmental and occupational health, safety, and the security of persons and properties.
- 2. Loss control committees serve various purposes, including:
 - a. to promote policies and programs that will provide a safe and healthy working for employees, and members of the public, and that will protect public property from injury or damage;
 - b. to endorse and systematically promote employee safety training;
 - c. to identify, correct, and report potential hazards and/or unsafe work practices; e.g. to review accident and loss summarized reports and statistics; and
 - d. to report at least annually to the agency head on safety initiatives and program development.
- 3. The MSU Loss Control Committee will include representatives from the following offices:
 - Director, Safety and Security (Chair of LCC)
 - Vice President of Student Affairs
 - Director, Human Resources
 - Director, Information Technology Center
 - Director, Physical Plant
 - Director, Custodial Services
 - Director, Public Information
 - Director, Residence Life
 - Director, Student Activities Director
 - Director, Student Health
 - Athletic Representative
 - Faculty Representative
- 4. Other employees may join the committee with approval from their supervisor and the Chair of the LCC.
