1) **Art Portfolio**

This includes a minimum of 10 examples of art work done by the student. These items can be in any medium and can include all one medium or a variety of mediums. Please include descriptions of materials used and size of art works.

2) **Cover Letter**

This letter should include a description of your motivation to create art in general, specific information about the works that you are including in your portfolio, your emphasis, or intended emphasis, at MSU (photography, painting, etc.), and the reasons why you are interested in receiving a scholarship.

3) **Transcript**

If you are an incoming freshman, please submit the most recent transcript from your high school. If you are a transfer or currently enrolled student, please submit your most recent MSU transcript. Both transcripts should include the current GPA.
