

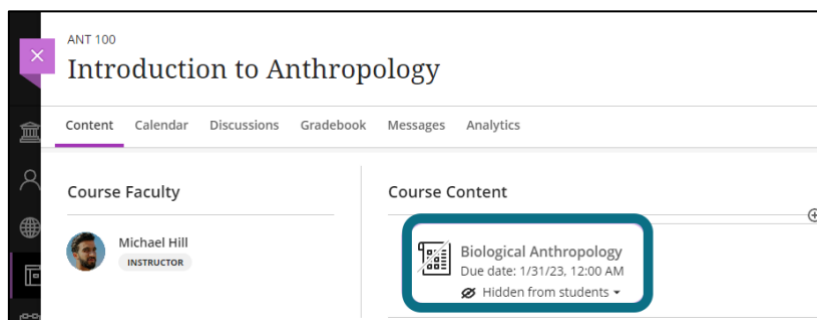
Creating a Verity Proctored Test in Blackboard Learn Ultra

Verity allows instructors to create and administer proctored assessments to test-takers, thereby safeguarding the integrity of assessments taken in their Learning Management System.

Creating a Verity Proctored Test

Before you enable Verity for your test, please make sure you have created a test in Blackboard Learn Ultra.

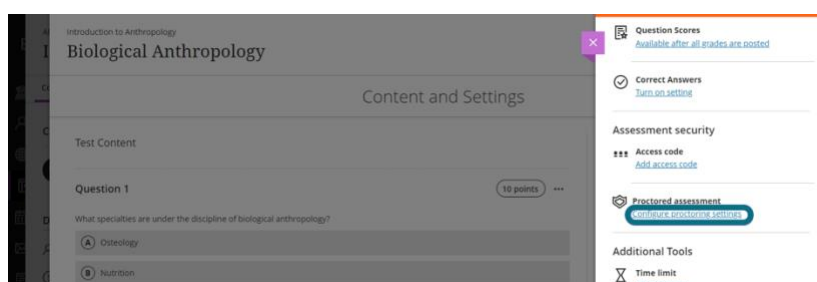
1. Select the test for which you'd like to enable Verity.



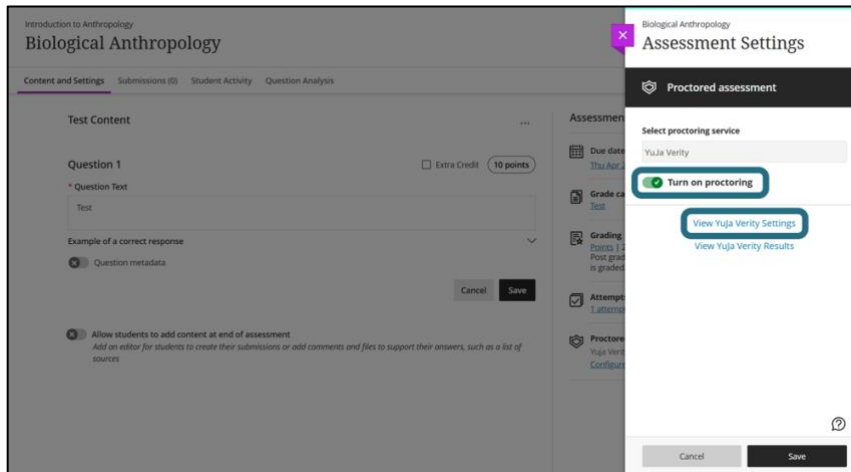
2. Click the **Gear** icon.



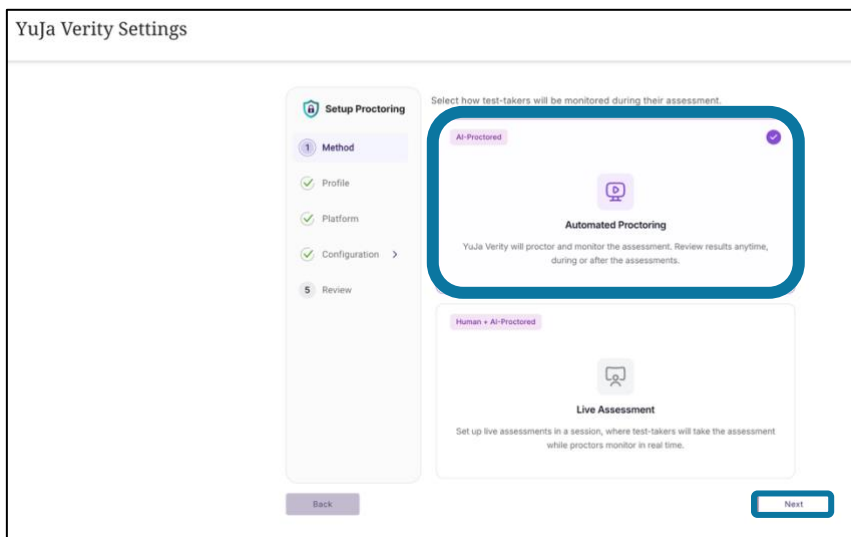
3. From the right-hand panel, scroll down and click **Configure proctoring settings**.



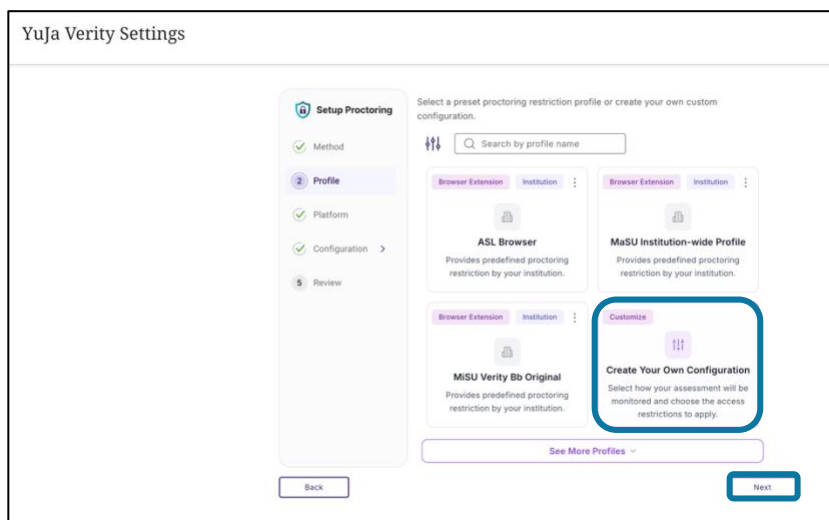
4. Select Turn on proctoring, then click View YuJa Verity Settings to configure the desired settings for the assessment.



5. Select **Automated Proctoring (Non-Live)**, then click **Next** to continue.



6. Select **Create Your Own Configuration** and click **Next**.



Choose **Create Your Configuration** only!

Choosing other profiles causes errors when students attempt to start their proctoring sessions.

7. Select the platform you'd like to enable and click **Next**.

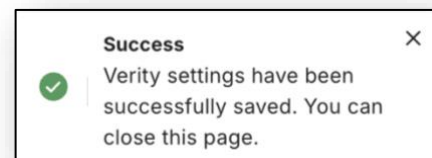
For **Record Video** and **Record Audio**, make sure the first check box is deselected, otherwise students can take the exam without the webcam or microphone activated.

9. (Optional) Set up accommodations to allow specific test-takers to take the assessment without being proctored or with a different proctoring profile.
10. Click **Next**.
11. Review your settings. When ready, click **Confirm**

14. Close the Assessment Settings pane, then close the assessment. The Verity Proctoring set up is now complete.
