- Development of an individualized pathway to a career in education

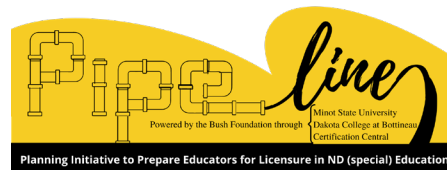
