

MINOT MODEL ALUMNI ASSOCIATION ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP AND OLGA PETERSEN SCHOLARSHIP

The Minot Model Alumni Association Endowed Scholarship Fund was established in 1991 to perpetuate the name and memory of MINOT MODEL HIGH SCHOOL and to provide financial assistance in the form of college scholarships to worthy and deserving students who are direct descendants of students who attended high school on the Minot State University campus. The doors of MODEL closed with the 1968 graduation class. The structure remains and is used by the University for Classroom and office space. It has been renamed MODEL HALL.

The Olga Petersen Scholarship Fund was established in 2001 through a gift from the estate of Amy Petersen, given in memory of her sister Olga Petersen who taught English at MINOT MODEL HIGH SCHOOL from 1932-39.

GUIDELINES

These Guidelines and the Application forms that follows serve **both** scholarships. There is additional eligibility Requirements for the Olga Petersen Scholarship as indicated in 4) of the Eligibility criteria, and the amount of the award is greater for those planning a teaching career (See Award Amounts and Disbursements below).

ELIGIBILITY:

- 1) Applicant must be a direct descendent (child, grandchild or great-grandchild) of a MINOT MODEL HIGH SCHOOL graduate or a student who attended and satisfactorily completed the full 1967-68 school year as a sophomore or junior at MINOT MODEL HIGH SCHOOL.
- 2) Applicant must demonstrate graduation from an accredited high school or equivalent.
- 3) Applicant must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher.

If applying for the Olga Petersen Scholarship:

- 4) **Applicant must be enrolled in college as a sophomore, junior or senior for the academic years following the application date with priority given those majoring in education and planning to teach following graduation**

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) Completed application form. The same application form is used for both scholarships.
- 2) Certified high school transcript. If applicant has completed some college study, a college transcript is required as well.
- 3) A copy of the letter of acceptance from the college where the applicant will be enrolled for the academic year following the date of application.

APPLICATION DEADLINE:

Applications and all supporting documents must be postmarked by 1 March. Scholarships will be awarded by the MMAA Scholarship Committee each spring for the following academic year. **You are eligible to receive one scholarship during your college career.**

AWARD AMOUNTS AND DISBURSEMENT:

- 1) The MMAA Scholarship Fund is an endowment, and the amount awarded each year varies with the interest earned. The number of awards may vary as well.
- 2) The amount available and the number of awards given through the Olga Petersen Scholarship may also vary.
- 3) The scholarship must be applied towards tuition fees at an accredited college or university of the applicants choice.
- 4) Funds will be forwarded directly to the institution where the recipient is enrolled. The funds will be applied to your tuition fees.

NOTIFICATION OF AWARD:

The Scholarship Committee will inform each applicant in writing of the results of his/her application. All awards will be made without regards to race, religion, age, color, gender, or national origin of the applicant.
