ELIGIBLE MEDIA

All media are eligible for consideration, and may fall under the following categories: Animation, Ceramics, Drawing, Glass, Graphic Arts/Visual Communication, New Media (video and time-based art), Metals/Jewelry, Mixed Media, Painting, Photography, Printmaking, Sculpture/Furniture.

ELIGIBILITY

- All Minot State University current and emeritus faculty and staff are eligible and encouraged to enter with no entry fee required. Two-dimensional and three-dimensional art and craft in any medium, traditional or experimental, qualify.
- All artworks must be original, finished and ready to exhibit. It is preferred that two-dimensional work be framed and protected by clear acrylic glazing, unless alternative display is integral to the work.
- If generative AI is used in the creation of an artwork in any capacity, approval must be given by the director. Such usage must be detailed in the artwork medium.
- Once accepted, work may not be removed during the show for any reason.
