

**Articulation Agreement**  
between  
**Minot State University and Williston State College**

The purpose of this memorandum is to clarify and set forth the essential terms of agreement between Minot State University (MiSU) and Williston State College (WSC) relating to curriculum requirements to be satisfied for any student attending WSC who desires admission into the Minot State University Social Work Program.

To be eligible for admission under the terms of this agreement, each WSC student must complete the Associate in Arts (AA) degree. If students do not complete the AA degree at WSC, they will be considered a transfer student in which all MiSU terms of admission, course requirements, and additional MiSU policies would apply.

Upon successful completion of the WSC degree, to transfer to the MiSU Social Work Program, it is agreed:

1. Students who successfully complete the courses/credits identified will earn an Associate in Arts Degree from the WSC. This degree allows students to be considered for admission into the Social Work Program at MiSU.
2. Students will apply for admission to MiSU by following admissions' policies.
3. MiSU will accept specified AA program courses as MiSU curricula equivalents (see Curriculum Guide in attached Appendix B).
  - a. Students completing AA degrees at WSC are considered General Education complete at MiSU.

Further, for admission to the MiSU Social Work Program, each student must:


1. Have earned a WSC minimal grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
2. Have earned a grade of "C" or better in the following pre-requisite WSC classes: COMM 212 and SWK 256.
3. Complete the application process required by the MSU Social Work Program (as followed when enrolled in SWK 330 and SWK 331) and be approved for admission to the Social Work Program.
4. Meet other MSU Social Work Program requirements which include a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale and a 2.5 social work GPA.
5. Satisfy all other degree requirements as prescribed in the MiSU catalog.

The terms of this agreement will be jointly reviewed by MiSU and WSC annually following the signature dates below with more frequent reviews as necessary (i.e., in the event of a course revision, etc.). Changes by one party to any aspect of the agreement will require notification of the other party and discussion of the agreement.


This agreement will be effective on the date signed and shall remain in effect until either party requests a review of or revision(s) to the agreement.

Under this agreement, Minot State University, and Williston State College may list this program in their catalogs and promotional literature.


