Articulation Agreement

Minot State University and United Tribes Technical College

Effective: Fall 2022 **Major:** Addiction Studies **Degree:** Bachelor of Science

The purpose of this articulation agreement is to enable students who have earned their Associate of Science (AS) degree from United Tribes Technical College (UTTC) to transfer to Minot State University (MSU) and enter the Addiction Studies Bachelor of Science (BS) degree program.

The information contained within this agreement pertains to the 2022-2023 MSU catalog. Students satisfactorily completing the UTTC courses below may transfer them to MSU in fulfillment of the corresponding course requirements for this degree.

Students will complete their Associate of Science (AS) degree from UTTC. The student will be considered to have completed their general education courses in their UTTC AS degree and will only need to complete the additional MSU courses listed on page 2 of this document to graduate from MSU with a B.S. in Addiction Studies.

UTTC students planning to transfer to MSU must have phone or e-mail contact with an adviser during their first semester at UTTC and first semester at MSU. Students may email Brett Williamson at UTTC at bwilliamson@uttc.edu or call Dr. Vicki Michels at MSU at 1-800-777-0750 or 1-701-858-3594.

Graduating with an Addiction Studies degree requires a cumulative GPA of 3.0 in the required Addiction Studies major courses.

Students must complete 60 credits at a four-year university and 30 credits to graduate from MSU. Students must have 120 total credit hours to graduate with their BS degree from MSU.

This internship can be undertaken during the student's matriculation at MSU.
