#### REPORT HIGHLIGHTS

The information for this report was collected through mail surveys, follow-up telephone calls, and inquiries to academic departments. The office of Career Services surveyed students who received degrees from MSU for the terms ending in December 2003, May 2004, and August 2004. This report is based on responses from 546 graduates (96.5% of the reported 566 degrees granted).

##### Of the 546 respondents:

--467 (85.5%) reported entering the job market.

--79 (14.5%) reported "Additional College."

##### Of the 467 respondents entering the job market:

--326 (70%) reported "Employed in Major" or "Employed Related to Major."

--30 (6%) reported still "Active in Job Search."

--Graduates reported accepting employment in 28 states and 5 foreign countries.

--332 respondents reported accepting employment in North Dakota.
