## F-1 Student Transfer Form for Applicants

Please complete Part I of this form before giving it to your current International Student Advisor (DSO). After you have been accepted to Minot State, remember to provide your current DSO with a copy of your Minot State acceptance letter so that your SEVIS record can be transferred.

Your SEVIS record must be transferred at least 15 days before classes begin at Minot State. If you have just graduated from another institution, your SEVIS record release date must be within 45 days of your graduation date. You are responsible for communicating with your current international advisor to arrange your SEVIS transfer. Minot State cannot accept terminated SEVIS records or those with pending reinstatement applications.
