Criteria:

The American Legion Unit # 26 Women's Auxiliary of Minot is taking applications for a \$500 scholarship for a Minot State University student Veteran/Spouse/Dependent to help offset the expense of an undergraduate or graduate degree at Minot State University.

The scholarship is intended to help the recipient pay for the cost of their education. It does not need to be used for tuition and fees. It can be used for books, supplies, and related expenses.

Application for the scholarship requires a completed Minot State University 2018-2019 General Scholarship & Award Program Application, and a written request describing the individuals need as well as an explanation of how the scholarship would help advance the recipient successfully towards graduation.

Please submit application by February 15, 2018 to the Veteran Services Office, Dakota Hall, Minot State University, 500 University Ave West, Minot, ND 58707.

Selection made by:

The Legion Auxiliary/Veteran center will choose the recipient and submit the individual's information to the Minot State University Financial aid office, who will notify the individual of the scholarship award.

How Awarded:

If there is a qualified applicant by the deadline for the fall award, the scholarship will be awarded \$250 for the fall term, \$250 for the spring term. If there is a qualified applicant for only the spring term, it will be awarded \$500 for the spring term. If there is not a qualified applicant during the school year, the scholarship will roll over to the next school year with the same guidelines.
