- 2. recognize the mutual influence and interaction of history, politics, economics, beliefs, cultural values, and communication styles.
- 3. assess one's cultural perspectives and values.
- 4. deconstruct one's biases and assumptions.
- 5. discern cultural impact on the development of values.
- 6. grasp the impact of values on decisions, emotions, and behaviors.
- 7. acknowledge and examine personal values.
- 8. identify community values.
- 9. perceive the interaction of personal and community values.

Course Guidelines:

- 1. The course must provide students with the knowledge and skills useful to appreciate and be aware of communities of different cultural values locally, nationally, and globally.
- 2. The course must require students to complete assignments which require them to display their awareness of the complexity of elements important to members of another culture in relation to its history, value, politics, communication styles, economy, or beliefs and practices.
