Bob and Kathy Mau Undergraduate Student Research Grant

The Bob and Kathy Mau Endowment provides funds that have been designated for support of undergraduate student geologic/earth science research in the Geosciences program at Minot State University. Once each semester, the Department of Geosciences accepts proposals from undergraduate students pursuing a program in Geosciences for financial support of their research projects. Funds awarded may be used toward:

- student travel expenses associated with field work, and/or
- equipment or supplies needed for field and/or laboratory work.

Priority will be given to expenses that would otherwise be incurred by the student – things for which other sources of support are not available. A student can apply more than once, but may receive only one grant.

Application Procedure

To apply for a Bob and Kathy Mau Undergraduate Student Research Grant, you must submit the following to the Program Coordinator of the Geosciences Department:

To simplify the process, you may use your proposal from SCI 240 if appropriate (could be from a previous semester)

Alternatively, write a proposal that includes a project description (introduction/background, methods, and research timeline), references cited, and a budget.

Awardees

Students receiving a Bob and Kathy Mau Endowment Student Research Grant are required to submit a final report following completion of the research. The report should summarize the work accomplished and details of how funds were used.
