Effective immediately, per recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control & Prevention (CDC) as well as the ND University System, Minot State University is canceling all University-funded and sponsored international travel outside the US. MSU will work with students, faculty, and staff to address any financial implications as a result of this decision. This only applies to University-funded/sponsored travel.

We will monitor the COVID-19 pandemic accordingly in the days and weeks ahead, and let the University community know when MSU-sponsored/funded international travel is allowed.

MSU students, faculty, and staff already abroad should adhere to CDC and U.S./State travel advisories. MSU students who feel sick are asked to contact Student Health Services at 701-858-3371 before coming to the clinic.
