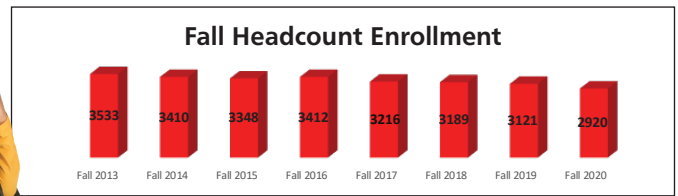

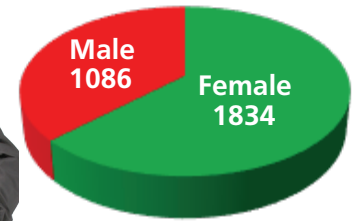

Gender Distribution of All Students



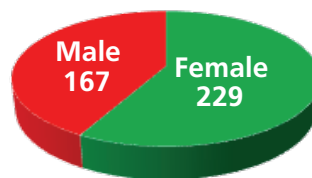

Gender Distribution of New First Year Freshmen



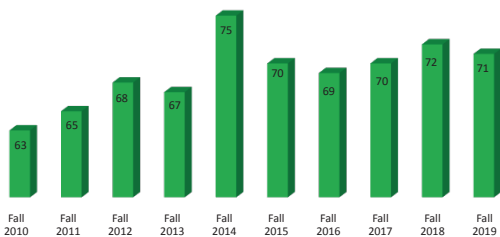

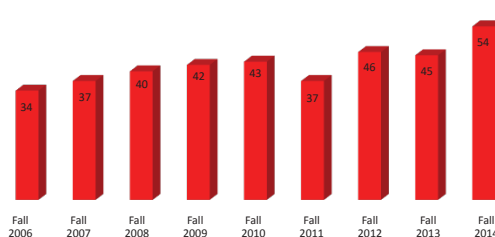

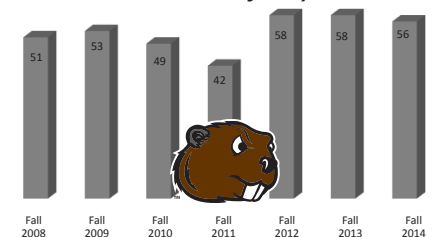
Retention Rate
