Federal regulations allow F-1 students to take courses at more than one institution as long as (8 CFR 214.2(f)(6)(iv)):

- Enrollment at both schools amounts to a full-time course load.
- Both schools are SEVIS certified.
- MSU will apply the courses taken at the other institution towards the student's program of study.

A full-time course load is defined as 12 credits for undergraduate students and 9 credits for graduate students.
