

Information on the ATI TEAS for Spring 2021

The Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) is required as part of the pre-admission to the Nursing Program at Minot State University.

Three dates have been set to take the ATI TEAS at the
MSU Nursing Department:

January 8th, 2021 at 8:30am
January 11th, 2021 at 12:30pm
January 25th, 2021 at 12:30pm

The tests will be taken in Memorial Hall Room 308 (3rd Floor).

To sign up for the TEAS test, email Abbie Baklenko, LRC Coordinator at abbie.baklenko@minotstateu.edu to reserve your spot and tell her which day would work for you. If you have any questions, comments, or concerns, please email her at the above email.

The cost of the TEAS is currently \$65. This is mandatory and must be paid with a credit or debit card at the time of the test. ***The fee is subject to change.***

In order to prepare for your TEAS test, please go to the ATI website at www.atitesting.com. You will find information about the TEAS test here. The TEAS test score will be used as part of the admission criteria. All applicants must take the ATI TEAS test and achieve a “proficient” level score to be eligible for admissions to the Nursing program. You are only allowed to take the TEAS test twice per application period.

On the day of the test, please remember your photo ID, credit/debit card, passwords for the www.atitesting.com site. Please make sure that you have been on the ATI website to get a login and password before the day of the test. It is always a good idea to arrive early for the test in case there are any problems. You will not be allowed to enter the testing area if you arrive late.
