

Getting Your Course Ready for a New Semester

Perform a Course Copy

1. Log into Blackboard: You will notice your course for the upcoming semester is listed and is **not currently available**. Click the course name to open the course shell.

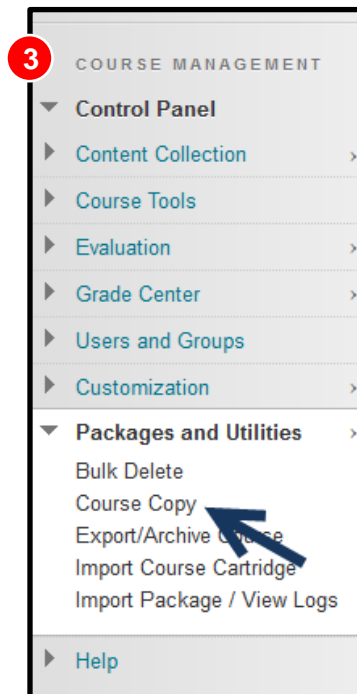
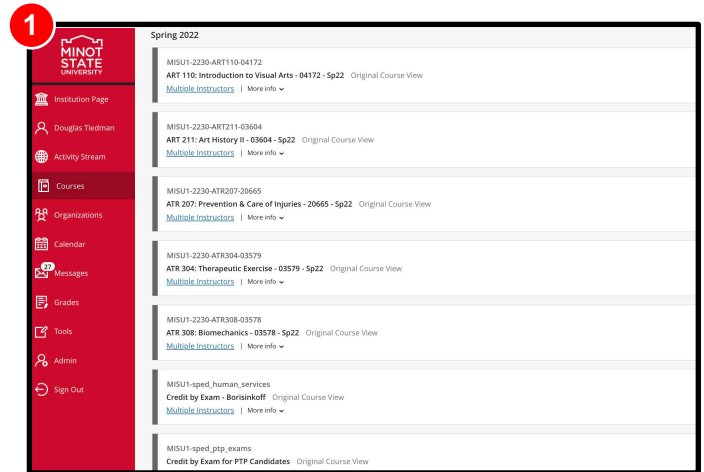


You may notice that upon opening the course shell the Simple Syllabus app opens automatically. This is normal and is occurring because there isn't any content in the course.

2. Next, content needs to be brought into the course. This content will either be from your storage shell or you may wish to use content from a previous semester's shell. To begin, go to the course that contains the content you want to copy.
3. Once inside the course shell you want to copy from, go to the **Course Menu** → **Packages and Utilities** → **Course Copy**. Click on **Course Copy**. Remember this is a one-time copy, you cannot try to copy the content again as you will end up with two of everything in your course.



Remember, this is a one-time copy. You CANNOT try to copy the content again. You will end up with duplicates of each item in the course.



4. In the first section of this tool you will see **Select Copy Type**. The default is set to **Copy Course Materials into a New Course**, this needs to be changed to **Copy Course Materials into an Existing Course**.
5. In the **Select Copy Options** section you will need to **Browse** for the course you want to copy the content into. You will need to know your class number and name for this step.
6. After clicking on **Browse** a list of classes in a new window will open. Select the current semester's shell and click on **Submit**.
7. Under the Select Course Materials section, click on the **Select All** button
8. Under the Discussion Board selection, select **Include only the forums, with no starter posts**. This will take all of the old posts out of the new shell.
9. In the **File Attachments** section make sure you select **Copy links and copies of the content (include entire course home folder)**.
10. Under the Enrollments section, leave the field **Include Enrollments in the Copy** unchecked.
11. Click the Submit button. The following message will appear:

Success: Course copy action queued. An email will be sent when the process is complete.

An email will be sent to you confirming the copy process has completed.

Course copy can make an exact copy of the course. Course copy can also make a copy of some of the materials and create a new course or add the materials to an existing course. You must have manage permission on these files to make copies of them. [More Help](#)

First Day of Class

On the first day of class the course shell needs to be made available to the students. This is an important step because students are already enrolled in the course (and will be looking for it on the first day).

1. Enter the course, then in the Course Menu, click on **Customization**→**Properties**.
2. Scroll down to the section titled **Set Availability**. Select **Yes** under **Make Course Available**. Click the **Submit** button.
3. Alternatively, there is a second way to make the course available. On the home page in the upper right of the screen, there is an icon that looks like a padlock that is in the “locked” position. Clicking this icon will now put it into an “unlocked” mode, which in turn makes the course available to students.
