Thank you for your continuing support of Minot State University this past year. We are eternally grateful for your tremendous generosity and fully realize the profound impact you have on the education we provide. Your support helps MSU fulfill its mission and embodies the transformative power education has and the unlimited potential it can help bring our students.

In supporting academic programs, the arts, and research, you encourage new learning, discoveries, performances, and scholastic growth. With scholarships, you help empower students to chase their dreams without the worry of financial burdens. By investing in infrastructure and campus facilities, you help us establish an environment favorable for collaborating, teaching, and learning. With athletics, you help ensure MSU student-athletes have opportunities to succeed both in and out of the classroom. Regardless of what you support, your generosity helps guarantee Minot State remains a beacon of opportunity for current and future generations of students.

As we prepare to welcome a new class of students for the 2024-25 academic year, there are numerous highlights from this past year – many of which are not possible without your support and investment in MSU.

We recently reopened Hartnett Hall following a nearly two-year closure while undergoing a \$26.6 million renovation; we added two new bachelor's degrees in data science and museum studies; and our focus has been on final stages of the \$50 million EMPOWER capital campaign that will conclude at the end of 2024, including its five pillars of student scholarships, academic programs, facilities, athletics, and the Vision Fund. MSU's new men's club soccer team won the Great Plains Soccer Conference

in its inaugural year, women's hockey finished as the ACHA Division 1 national champion runners-up for the second consecutive year, and men's hockey coach Wyatt Waselenchuk was named the 2024 ACHA D1 national coach of the year. We dedicated the Plum River Native Prairie project, an urban prairie restoration located on the former Erik Ramstad Middle School property just south of MSU; Spring 2024 student enrollment increased over last year; a record of nearly \$428,000 was raised in 24 hours during our sixth annual Giving Day; and MSU hosted major events and speakers including president and CEO Neel Kashkari of the Federal Reserve Bank of Minneapolis, the Recovery Reinvented conference with Gov. Doug Burgum and First Lady Kathryn Burgum, and Minot native and world-renowned Egyptologist Mark Lehner.

Thank you again for your belief in Minot State University along with the tremendous support you provide our students and wonderful team of employees. We are proud of our work educating students while also creating important opportunities for them to grow, succeed, and create new pathways in life. We are excited about the new year ahead, and I hope to see many of you at Homecoming as well as numerous other events throughout the remainder of the year.


Total Support By All Donors

In fiscal year 2024, endowed funds provided \$2 million in support of Minot State, with 75% of the funds supporting student scholarships and academic programs.



The \$9.2 million in total donor gifts were distributed among five University priorities.




Annual Excellence Donations

Our Annual Excellence Appeal is critical to the support of the University.




Faculty and Staff Giving





» Establishing a **SCHOLARSHIP**

CREATING A NAMED SCHOLARSHIP through the Minot State University Development Foundation assists students and leaves a legacy at Minot State University. It is also a meaningful way to honor family and friends.

The first step is to determine whether you would like to establish an endowed scholarship or an annual scholarship.

Endowed Scholarships

Endowed scholarship funds are designed to be permanent and can be created with gifts totaling a minimum amount of \$10,000 contributed in full at the outset or with an initial commitment that is added to over time until the endowment level of \$10,000 is reached. The principal of the fund is invested to produce income, and an annual award is made to a student(s). The principal remains untouched so the endowment can last into perpetuity.

Annual Scholarships

Annual scholarships can be established with an outright gift of any amount. Unlike an endowed scholarship, an annual scholarship is not a permanent fund and is awarded only as long as you (or others) choose to contribute to the fund.

As a scholarship donor, you choose the name and the criteria. The Development Foundation staff is available to help you with the process. Endowed and annual scholarships are awarded to students based upon area of interest, geographical origin, merit, financial need, academic achievement, or other criteria.

Typically, a selection committee carefully reviews the scholarship applications submitted by students and selects the most deserving recipient(s) based on the donor-established criteria.

Contributors of a scholarship fund are notified annually when the scholarship recipient(s) has been selected and are informed of the name, as well as the amount of the award. Recipients often write a thank you note to the donor, and in some cases the recipient(s) and donor are able to meet.

BRENT AND STACY (HOAG) ASKVIK HAVE BEEN AFFORDED MANY ADVANTAGES FROM THEIR ASSOCIATION WITH MINOT STATE UNIVERSITY.

Now, the couple is giving back to ensure the next generation has the same opportunities.

"If there's anything about Minot State for us, it was the opportunities. We had a chance to try new things. Then we both ended up coming back here to work," Brent said.

Brent '81/'82 retired in 2020 as the executive director of the North Dakota Center for Persons with Disabilities (NDCPD) and professor of special education emeritus after working at Minot State for over 33 years. He earned his bachelor's and master's degrees at Minot State and his doctorate at the University of Idaho. Stacy '81 earned her bachelor's degree in medical technology at Minot State and her master's degree from the University of North Dakota in 1993. She worked as director of the laboratory at the UND Center for Family Medicine for 30 years. Stacy is also a former adjunct professor for hematology and parasitology classes and a current volunteer coach for the women's wrestling team at Minot State.

Brent had many opportunities to travel during his time at Minot State, even while he was faculty. The grants and endowments available to the NDCPD allowed for those opportunities.

"We got to travel a lot in the U.S. and internationally because of my position at NDCPD. Some of the grants were to work with other countries and so, we were in Norway 15 to 16 times and the Netherlands, Prague, and Italy working with folks from all over the world," Brent said. "That opportunity, that all the people who wrote our textbooks and who gave lectures when we went to national conferences, those were all our colleagues, and we're all on a first-name basis. Minot State gave that to us."

Before his retirement, Renae Yale '10, MSU Development Foundation database manager and longtime friend, encouraged Brent to start

an endowment at the University. He knew all too well what this would mean for future students and faculty, so the couple decided to increase the NDCPD endowment.

"We super-sized it," Brent said. "We put our name on it, and we gave them enough money so that they actually could go and get the match from the ND Challenge Grant Program. Rick (Hedberg '89, MSU Development Foundation executive director) was able to go and get that and the same with Stacy's scholarship."

For Stacy, wrestling has always been a part of her life, from playing with her family as a kid to watching her classmates in high school and later her own boys. She had already been helping the women's wrestling team by volunteering as an assistant coach and outfitting the locker room. Stacy partnered with Brittney Mitchem, MSU head women's wrestling coach, to determine the details for the first women's wrestling academic scholarship, named Stacy and Brent Askvig Women's Wrestling Scholarship.

"Women's wrestling is growing big time in the country, and I wanted to support that to keep it going. We know how hard it is to recruit people to Minot. They don't have the money for scholarships like your bigger universities, and so I thought that would help wrestling because Brittney is competing against larger universities, and it's difficult to recruit up here," Stacy said. "The students have to have a very good academic score to get the scholarship. Actually, Brittney was tougher about that than I was."

The couple's dedication to their passions for the NDCPD and the women's wrestling team is an opportunity they want to extend to future students and faculty.

"We just want to do a part of letting other people have those opportunities," Brent said. "We've been blessed by what we've been able to do at Minot State and what we've been able to gain from that. We want to give back." ❖❖❖





TECHNOLOGY CAN CHANGE IN WHAT FEELS LIKE AN INSTANT.

Working nearly 30 years as a geophysicist, Don Selk '72 has kept up with the latest geological advancements, even since retiring in 2003. Among all the changes, he continues to remember his time at Minot State as building a strong foundation, and he hopes to help future geophysicists from the University do the same.

When Selk chose to stay in his hometown for college, he didn't know exactly what major to choose, but when he started taking classes, the answer was easy.

"Geology Professor DeWayne Martin and Dr. Charles Hoffman in biology motivated me to pursue a career in science. Their lectures were nothing short of inspirational," he said.

Selk graduated with a major in earth science and concentrations in mathematics, physics, and geography. After MSU, he earned a master's in geophysics from the University of Utah and promptly started as a geophysicist for Chevron. He worked there his entire career where he gathered and processed seismic data using computer mapping, 3D computer modeling, and data visualization of the Earth's subsurface. The resulting maps and models were valuable in Chevron's oil exploration efforts. He was stationed in many cities across the United States, from San Francisco to New Orleans, as well as Alberta, Canada, and Khartoum, Sudan.

His undergraduate education came in handy through it all.

"My first year at grad school, I was surprised at

how much I carried over from the coursework at Minot State," he said. "I really enjoyed the classes, the math professors, the geology, the chemistry. I enjoyed all the science classes. That's what really helped me in grad school and in my career."

Today, Selk has established two endowments for Minot State students who want to pursue careers like his. One endowment is for data science, and the other for geoscience.

"I was thinking of myself back then, and I just wanted to help students who were interested in those careers to help them get going and pursue that," he said. "Since my career combined both of those, I thought it was only appropriate that I give back to Minot State for helping me have such a nice career."

For students who are interested in geophysics, Selk has one piece of advice.

"Take as many math, science, and computer science classes as you can," he said. "Many colleges didn't even have a data science curriculum until the last few years. You never heard of those terms in the 70s and 80s, but you can make a career out of it now. It was a real eye-opener. I was happy I was working with that information. That's where the math classes and science classes at Minot State really helped."

All in all, no matter where his career took him, Selk used the strong educational foundation he received from Minot.

"I really enjoyed my time there," he said. "I got into the science end of it and was lucky to get into a career that was in demand, so big plus to Minot State for helping me out." ❖❖❖



SACRAMENTO, CALIFORNIA

JUDIE BOEHMER'S '88 JOURNEY IS A TESTAMENT TO THE PROFOUND IMPACT OF EDUCATION AND COMMUNITY SUPPORT, WHICH HAVE SHAPED HER INTO A DISTINGUISHED LEADER IN THE NURSING PROFESSION.

Fueled by gratitude, Boehmer aims to support the next generation of nurses.

"I was very fortunate to have a father who knew what it meant to have a bachelor's degree. My dad would always say, 'Education is power' and 'Give back to your community and take care of those who have taken care of you.' I felt like Minot State had taken care of me, and my parents had also felt I was safe there," Boehmer said. "I was fortunate to have their support. I would hear about other students with responsibilities such as providing food and a home for their family while trying to go to school and better themselves. If there's anything I can do to help and pay it forward for someone else, that's what I want to do."

Boehmer earned a bachelor's degree in nursing from Minot State in 1988 and had a promising lineup of interviews awaiting her in Sacramento, California.

"I left North Dakota a month after graduation and drove my Dodge Turismo to Sacramento, California. I felt right at home seeing a John Deere working the rice fields off the side of the freeway," Boehmer said. "I started interviewing for nursing positions in December before graduating. I had 14 interviews and received an offer from each. I felt I had been incredibly prepared with the education I received from Minot State.

"I not only learned the science of nursing at MSU but also the art. The art of being a caring, empathetic, and compassionate nurse to those I care for and those I serve as a leader."

Boehmer has spent 33 years working in various nursing and leadership roles at the University of California Davis Medical Center in Sacramento. She earned her master's degree in nursing administration from the University of Phoenix. She completed a fellowship at the Advisory Board Company in Washington, D.C., and attended the Executive Nursing Leadership Program at The Wharton School of Business in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. In 2021, she transferred to the University of California San Francisco, where she currently serves as the vice president and chief

nursing officer for the University of California, San Francisco Benioff Children's Hospitals in San Francisco and Oakland, California.

The assistance from the Minot State faculty gave her the confidence to excel as a registered nurse.

"The nursing faculty were great at Minot State; they were tough and were preparing us to join a noble profession. One instructor, Judy Swanson '74 (professor emeritus, nursing), had a lot of faith in me, and I am forever grateful for her support. She was someone I connected with and looked up to. We have remained connected through all these years. I had so much support getting through school," Boehmer reflected. "Not everybody has that."

In 2019, the MSU Development Foundation reached out, and Boehmer knew the time had come to show that same support.

"Jeremy (Feller '07, MSU Development Foundation development officer) reached out," she said. "I thought, now is the time. We are dealing with an incredible nursing shortage in every state."

Boehmer said her father would tell her, "Never forget where you came from. It's because of all those who supported you and Minot State for the success and person you are today. I owe it to my profession and Minot State so they can continue to produce highly skilled, competent nurses."

Philanthropy is significant to Boehmer. In 2019, she received the University of California, Davis Stewardship Award for her contribution to raising funds for the UC Davis Children's Hospital. Boehmer was the first nurse in UC Davis's history to receive this award.

Her gratitude prompted her to establish the Leonard Boehmer Memorial Scholarship Endowment and fueled her desire to inspire others to act similarly.

"I hope it inspires others to do the same thing and pay it forward in their career to someone else and just continue that giving," Boehmer said. "Hopefully, this will help create more nurses and contribute to our wonderful profession.

"I am forever grateful." ❖❖❖

Minot State University expanded Kevin Harmon's role into the newly established position of vice president for student affairs and intercollegiate athletics.



Vida Mae and Lawrence (Pete) Petersen believe the spirit of their daughter, Tracy, lives on in the lives of the students who have been impacted by the Tracy Petersen Snyder Memorial Scholarship.

"After Tracy's sudden death, it was very im-

portant to us that her memory would live on and creating a scholarship in her name at Minot State, where she had received her nursing degree, would fulfill that wish," Vida Mae said.

And it's not just anecdotal.

"Tracy's sister, who is a doctor in Minneapolis, had a conversation with a patient and found out that the patient's daughter, who is now a nurse in Minneapolis, had received one of the scholarships!" she said. "The legacy goes on."

Tracy graduated from MSU with a degree in nursing in 1983. She died unexpectedly in March 1995.

The family felt it was only fitting to set up the fund to help future pediatric nurses, reflecting Tracy's professional skill and interest in the nursing care of children.


"To single out pediatric nursing was an easy decision," Vida Mae said. "Since childhood, Tracy had medical problems and had numerous stays in the hospital, and the nurses she had were always special. We felt this was a way to give back to the great care she received and may have started her desire to become a pediatric nurse."

The Petersen's also felt academic proficiency should outweigh financial needs to reflect their daughter's academic success.

"Although Tracy was an excellent student, she was never given the recognition of getting a scholarship because of her financial standing," Vida Mae said. "We wanted students with high scholastic scores to be recognized.

"Students who receive the scholarship know they have been chosen to carry on the work that Tracy had started."

ANTON HUETHER'S PHILANTHROPIC IDEOLOGY IS PRETTY SIMPLE.

If you want to see change, you have to make it happen, even if it starts small.

"It doesn't really matter how much you give or what areas you give to, it just takes someone to get it going," he said. "One area I've been drawn to is the MSU Greenhouse. I'm not necessarily that into it, it wasn't my major, but I walk by it every day. It's easy to walk around and not notice things, but it was something I could see and something I felt needed to get done.

"I feel I've reached a spot in my life where I should be giving back."

Huether, MSU's webmaster, has been associated with Minot State since his undergraduate days, earning a bachelor's degree in 2002 in art and graphic design with concentrations in marketing, broadcasting, and the MSU Honors Program. Even before his first class as a senior at Stanley High School, he was able to make connections that would serve him well into his future.

"I had no clue what I wanted to do, but I wanted to stay close to home, so I toured and met Bill Harbort (MSU art professor)," Huether said. "Bill had a great portfolio. I looked at what the department offered and thought I could make a career out of that."

His relationship with Harbort kicked off his career. Harbort first hired Huether for a job in the department and then connected him with Joe Ferrara, the director of the North Dakota Center for Persons with Disabilities (NDCPD).

"I had a work-study job in the art department and made a website for them. At the end of my first year, Bill helped me get a job with NDCPD, and ironically, it was an NDCPD grant that provided my Mac in high school that started my interest in computers," he said. "I worked for NDCPD for four years, building websites and graphics. They

employed quite a few students to work on grant-based assistive technology. It was a really great opportunity during the tech boom that we were all fortunate to be involved in but probably didn't understand how fortunate. We were getting paid to work on all the new stuff as the web was rapidly changing the world."

It was during this time building sites he would find his eventual calling.

"I was probably one of the few people growing up who had a computer," he recalled. "I made my first website on the Macs in high school. After getting to do a few sites, I felt I could make a living with it.

"I got a chance to make the Red & Green's first site and Student Government Association's first site – if you needed a website, I was pretty much the person doing it. I'm not sure I made much money off of those projects, but they were building my portfolio."

Huether feels his giving is tied to helping future students gain the hands-on learning experiences he received early in his academic career. As a former recipient of the Harvey & Arlone Twyman Scholarship, he understands the direct, immediate impact giving can have on a student.

"I think it is all about opportunities," he said. "I built a good portfolio and a referral from an NDCPD co-worker, Chad Fenner '99, to get a job at Stevick (Business Specialties and Advertising). That built it a little more and the reference on my resume was priceless. When the job opened up in IT at MSU, I was here, I had been working on similar projects, I knew everyone, so it was a good fit for me and for the University. The Twyman (how art students referred to the scholarship) helped prop up many starving art students over the years.

"Without each of those opportunities, I wouldn't have been able to achieve what I have. Maybe it's a small amount to me, but it becomes an opportunity for someone else." ❄️❄️❄️

SEATTLE, WASHINGTON

IF THERE IS ANY ONE EXPERIENCE THAT DESCRIBES THE DUALITY OF ROSANNE OLSON'S UNDERGRAD YEARS AT MINOT STATE, IT'S PROBABLY THIS: WHEN A SNAKE GOT LOOSE IN THE CYRIL MOORE SCIENCE CENTER.

"One time, at the start of a film studies class, a large snake somehow got loose near the entryway to the auditorium," she said. "There was quite a bit of commotion and chaos around the creature's escape. When no one came to claim it, I picked it up behind the head and tail (having never touched a snake before), so it would not bite me, and gingerly carried it off to someone who could take care of it. I always chuckle that it was a perfect example of art plus science in the same place at the same time."

Though Olson '72 had always envisioned herself as an artist, per her parents' preference, she graduated with a medical technology degree from Minot State. However, she ended up studying both, overloading her semesters with extra art and English credits and taking summer classes every year.

"I was able to choose a broad education in both art and science," she said. "It was unusual, but no one said no to that. People were supportive all the way."

Since then, Olson has come to see many connections between art and science, as well as art and almost everything. Unwittingly, her first introduction to photography – which became her career – started with a biology class in photomicrography.

"We would photograph cells under a microscope and develop the negatives into black and white prints in a small darkroom in the science building," Olson said. "I remember the smell of the stop bath (acetic acid) and the fixer. I remember the wonder of seeing a print emerge from the developer. And I remember being amazed at the complexity of cells and the complexity of the body in general. It was as if I was star-gazing inward."

While that experience didn't manage to directly lead Olson to her photography career, she ended

up there anyway. Earning a master's degree in journalism with a special focus on art from the University of Oregon in 1981 gave her the opportunity to practice her craft and eventually create her own photography business in Seattle in 1986, where she still is today.

Throughout all the photographic work she has created, including collaborations with the New York City Ballet, Seattle Opera, and Seattle Children's Hospital, she hasn't forgotten her alma mater.

"Minot State has invited me to participate in a number of group and solo shows over the years," she says. "It culminated at the Northwest Arts Center in 2022, with a retrospective of my career's work as a photographer, beautifully curated by Greg Vettel '09, Northwest Arts Center director. Minot State has also invited me to teach workshops to some of the photography classes and lecture to the art students and the community at large. The arts are the place of my heart, and to feel supported by Minot State as I have been, compels me to support it right back."

Earlier this year, Olson established two endowments, one for art students and one for the Northwest Arts Center. She lives in Seattle with her husband, Ted McMahon, a retired pediatrician. She continues to do portrait photography and she and her husband are deeply involved with the music and poetry communities in Seattle.

"I love the education I got at Minot State," she says. "Going to a small college in my hometown, I was not sure how it would stand up against any other college or university, but when I took the Graduate Records Exam (GRE) to get into grad school at the University of Oregon, my undergraduate education held me in good stead. I want to support the arts at Minot State because they have been so supportive of me." ❖❖❖

Minot State University and the Northwest Arts Center (NAC) worked in collaboration with the Mandan Hidatsa Arikara (MHA) Interpretive Center to repatriate a war shirt of Chief Drags Wolf to his descendants in November. An important piece of Hidatsa heritage, the war shirt has been in Minot State's possession as part of the Ralph Hubbard Special Collection. Hubbard, a former professor at MSU, donated it as part of his extensive collection to the University in 1986. MSU personnel traveled to the MHA Interpretive Center in New Town and met with more than two dozen of Drags Wolf's descendants, for an emotional ceremony returning the war shirt that included prayers, riders from the X'oshga Clan, and a drum to perform his song welcoming the war shirt home.



» HIGHLIGHT

Minot State followed up a successful cyber boot camp in the summer of 2023 with an AI for Teachers Workshop in the summer of 2024. The Dakota Digital Academy (DDA), a unit of the North Dakota University System (NDUS), and the Northern Information Technology Consortium (NITC) teamed up to deliver a two-day IT/cyber bootcamp at six locations across the state in 2023, while MSU faculty Nigel George, associate professor of physics, and Daren Erisman, assistant professor of computer science, teamed with the DDA for the 2024 workshop. Gov. Doug Burgum signed HB1398 during the 2023 Legislative Session, requiring the teaching of computer science and cybersecurity and the integration of these content standards into school coursework from kindergarten through 12th grade, making North Dakota the first state in the nation to approve legislation requiring cybersecurity education.
