To Semester 1 Athletic Training Students,

It is *your responsibility* to complete this form, provide records, submit the information to the Student Health Center for verification, and submit the completed copy to the Athletic Training Program Director’s Office. Please see the instructions**. **You will need to submit records of receiving your annual flu vaccination (or signed declination form) and TB testing to the Student Health Center and the Athletic Training Program Director.**

The North Dakota University System requires all students to have 2 doses of MMR and 1 dose of Meningitis within the past 5 years for those students 21 years and younger living in campus housing. Additional vaccines are required by the Athletic Training Program to be in compliance with clinical site requirements. Please note the requirements for each vaccination (or titer) and TB test. Attach a copy of vaccination records and/or proof of immunity and TB documentation to this form. If applicable include IGRA results, TB treatment or Chest X-ray results. Submit the information to **the Student Health Center for verification. Once complete, provide **this form with Student Health verification to the Athletic Training Program Director**, Swain Hall 108E. This must be complete by the date of application to the athletic training program.

TB testing and all required vaccines are available at the Student Health Center. Cost varies depending on your insurance. Please schedule an appointment if you have any questions by calling 701-858-3371. Please do not email our office as we cannot guarantee confidentiality with email.
