Interpretation

The survey was administered in Spring 2025 to 16 employers, with a 50% return rate. Data from the employer satisfaction survey indicates that employers are either satisfied or very satisfied with all aspects of preparation of advanced special education completers. Completers' ability to support p12 student programs, services and outcomes as well as completers' abilities to demonstrate leadership and advance policies that support students with disabilities was rated relatively higher.
