To gain admission to the Teacher Education Unit, you must complete all of the following steps.

All steps must be completed or your application *will not be processed*.

- 1. Login to SLL and navigate to the Admission Gateway.
- 2. <u>Admission Application</u> Fill out the form located here https://forms.office.com/r/JA1h9jigFx
 After you have completed the form, navigate to the Admission Application Section and click the Acknowledgement.
 - a. You will need the following information for the Form above.
 - i. GPA's
 - 1. General Education Communications GPA (2.5 minimum; no grade below a C) (English 110, English 120, Communications 110, or equivalent)
 - 2. Major GPA (2.5 minimum) (found on your Academic Requirements Report in Campus Connection)
 - 3. Cumulative GPA (2.75 GPA) (found on your Academic Requirements Report in Campus Connection)
 - ii. Which semester you completed (or are completing) ED 260L (or applicable transfer course)
 - iii. CASE Test Scores or ACT Test scores, if Applicable.
- 3. <u>Reading, Writing, and Math Competency</u> You must provide proof you have appropriate General Knowledge in Reading, Writing, and Math. Please upload PDF proof for each of your Reading, Writing, and Math Competencies in this section. (For Example: Praxis scores, ACT Scores, Course Grades, etc.)
- 4. NDBCI Background Check You must upload a PDF of your most recent background check or a PDF of the email you received in regard to you most recent background check. If you need assistance with the background check, see Deb Ringham in Swain 218.
- 5. <u>Advisor Sign-off Form</u> You and your advisor should go through the steps on this form and verify all have been completed. Once signed, you can upload the form to SLL.

Students who have met all other requirements for Admission to Teacher Education and do not hold an overall GPA of 2.75, but do demonstrate 3.00 GPA in their last 45 semester hours of study, may petition for special review by TEAC for admission to Teacher Education. Students granted admission by TEAC under this provision must demonstrate an overall GPA of 2.75 prior to Student Teaching.

Students who do not meet the cumulative GPA are also allowed to file an appeal to TEAC and submit a GPA calculation that counts only courses required for the full four-year degree (including general education courses). Students must upload the paper with the advisor's re-calculation on it with this application.

If Necessary, Recalculated GPA Information Must be uploaded in Advisor Form Section in SLL.
