



Dear Parent,

The Minot State University Reading Clinic is accepting students who have been enrolled in Kindergarten or 1st grade during the 2022 - 2023 school year for our summer Early Literacy Camp. This program is intended for students experiencing difficulty in reading and provides an opportunity for your child to work in a small group (2-3 children per group) with someone to improve his or her skills and attitudes towards reading. We strongly believe that a child must enjoy reading so some of our time will be spent pursuing reading through the child's interests in a variety of topics.

- Reading sessions will be planned and conducted by students working for university credit so there will be no tuition charge.
- ✤ A \$15.00 fee, due at the time of acceptance, is requested so we can replace materials.
- Sessions with the children will take place on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9-11 or 1-3 and Monday and Wednesdays from 9-11 or 1-3. You should register for only one session. Early Literacy Camp runs from and will last for 7 weeks (June 14 – July 21, 2022).
- Please do not register for the clinic if your child will need to miss more than 3sessions.
- We will not know how many clinicians we will have until May 2023, so we cannot guarantee you a place until then. You will be contacted sometime after May 1st regarding whether or not we have been able to accept your child for the summer session.
- Decisions about acceptance are based on quick return of the application and documentation of a Fountas and Pinnel reading level between PreA and F (late Kindergarten to early 1st grade) or the equivalent depending on the assessments available at your school.
