

Completion Rate

Minot State University (MSU) tracks all teacher candidates from the time of admission to teacher education until degree completion.

Admission to teacher education is a process normally (but not always) completed during the sophomore year. The teacher candidate must have a sufficient GPA, a satisfactory background check, satisfactory scores on the Core Academic Skills for Educators math, reading, and writing exams, and be enrolled in or have completed ED 260L – Clinical I.

The completion rates provided here signify which of those admitted candidates finish their degree. So, for example, of all students admitted during Fall 2013, 93% completed their B.S.Ed.

*There are a variety of reasons why teacher candidates do not complete. This table shows the overall completion and non-completion rate. Of the 22 teacher candidate who did not complete, 17 of them left the program of their own volition, 4 were terminated in the program, and 1 is in a remediation process.

*Fall 2013: Of the 5 teacher candidates who did not complete, 4 left the program of their own volition, 1 was terminated, and none are in remediation.

**Spring 2014: Of the 5 teacher candidates who did not complete, 3 left the program of their own volition, 1 was terminated and none are in remediation.

***Fall 2014: Of the 6 teacher candidates who did not complete, 4 left the program of their own volition, 1 was terminated in the program, and 1 is in remediation.

****Spring 2015: Of the 2 teacher candidates who did not complete, 2 left the program of their own volition, none were terminated in the program, and none are in remediation.

*****Fall 2015: Of the 1 teacher candidates who did not complete, 0 left the program of their own volition, 1 was terminated in the program, and none are in remediation.

*****Spring 2016: Of the 1 teacher candidates who did not complete, 1 left the program of their own volition, none were terminated in the program, and none are in remediation.

*****Fall 2016: Of the 3 teacher candidates who did not complete, 3 left the program of their own volition, none were terminated in the program, and none are in remediation.
