- \triangle All students are to be vaccinated with two doses of measles, mumps, and rubella.
- All newly admitted students ages 21 and younger must provide documentation of meningitis vaccination (MCV4, Menveo, or Menactra) given after the 16th birthday. Meningococcal B and Meningococcal C vaccine such as Trumenba and Bexsero do not fulfill the requirement.
- riangle All students are also required to complete the Tuberculosis (TB) Screening Questionnaire Form.
- All students under the age of 18 years must have a parent or guardian complete the Parent Consent for Minor form to receive services at MSU Student Health.
- Required documentation must be submitted through the MSU Student Health Portal, Student Health will no longer accept paper documentation submitted via fax, e-mail, mail, or hand delivery.
