Good versus Well

Which word goes where?

Good:

- ✓ An_sAdjective
- ✓ Describes/Renames a noun
- ✓ It will follow the verb Be
- ✓ Follows sense verbs

He is a good actor. — Describes what type of an actor.

The puppy was good today. \leftarrow Follows a *Be* verb.

Well:

- ✓ Most commonly an Adverb ′
- ✓ Describes how something was done
- ✓ Only an adjective when describing *health*
- ✓ Well can be replaced with a different adverb

You did well on the test. ← Describes *how* the person did on the test.

The patient isn't well.
Describes the patient's physical health.
